<p>Ordinarily one or more of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 Unsatisfactory grade in a preclerkship course • 3 or more Marginal Satisfactory grades in preclerkship courses • 1 Unsatisfactory grade in a core clerkship or clinical elective • 2 or more failures of shelf exams or other objective exams in core clerkships • Requirement to discontinue participation in PCE for academic reasons • Failure of either USMLE Step 1 or Step 2 (CK and/or CS) • Noncompliance with PRB conditions • Continuing pattern of formal notice (3 or more) • Failure to meet HMS standards of professional conduct and responsibility 	<p>Remedial program* for student created by Society and/or the Office of Advising Resources and approved by PRB.</p> <p>Students on MAS may not serve on appointed committees at the School, are required to limit* their extracurricular activities, and are ordinarily not granted a leave of absence for other than medical reasons.</p> <p>*Remedial program must include a statement of degree to which activities are to be limited and must be approved by the PRB.</p> <p>When appropriate, the PRB will be responsible for working with the Society and/or the student to ensure that the student has reflected on and learned from the experience.</p> <p>At an appropriate time during the period of MAS the student must work with the Society to prepare a written account for PRB review about what has been learned from the experience.</p> <p>Society reports back to PRB at regularly scheduled meetings about student progress, with particular focus on what she/he has learned from the experience.</p>	<p>Student receives written notice regarding PRB concerns and placement of student on MAS. Written notice cc'd to Society, Registrar, the Dean for Students and the Dean for Medical Education.</p> <p>The PRB may inform one or more course director(s) of a student's past performance in other courses prior to the student's starting a course.</p> <p>MAS is not reported in the student's permanent academic record.</p>	<p>Ordinarily for period of one year with extension if necessary.</p>
