

HARVARD PETITION FOR WAIVER OF NON-CUSTODIAL PARENT FINANCIAL INFORMATION

Harvard Medical School's policy requires financial information from both parents to determine a student's need for institutional aid. The HMS Financial Aid Office recognizes that extenuating circumstances in individual cases may make it impossible to obtain information from a non-custodial parent. If the non-custodial parent's whereabouts are unknown, if there has been extremely limited or no contact with the non-custodial parent for a significant period of time, or if there are certain other extenuating circumstances, the CSS Profile for Noncustodial Parent Form may be exempted from the required financial aid documentation. By completing this form, you are petitioning that an exception be made to the requirement of financial information from your non-custodial parent. A decision on the aid application cannot be made until the CSS Profile for Noncustodial Parent Form is received or a waiver is approved. *Unwillingness of a noncustodial parent to contribute financially is not a sufficient reason to file this
