2016 Joseph B. Martin Dean's Leadership Award for the Advancement of Women Faculty

The Dean's Award for Leadership in the Advancement of Women Faculty was initiated in 1998 by Joseph B. Martin, M.D., Ph.D., former Dean of the Faculty of Medicine, to recognize faculty members committed to the recruitment, retention and advancement of women at Harvard Medical School and Harvard School of Dental Medicine. In 2007, the Award was renamed the "Joseph B. Martin Dean's Leadership Award for the Advancement of Women" to honor Dr. Martin for his long-standing support of this effort.

The nomination process for the Award is coordinated by the Joint Committee on the Status of Women at HMS and HSDM.

- Candidates may be of any gender and may be nominated by any HMS/HSDM faculty member.
- The award recipient will be recommended by the JCSW Dean's Award Selection Subcommittee and selected by Jeffrey S. Flier, M.D., Dean of the Faculty of Medicine.
- The faculty awardee will receive a cash award and will be recognized at the May 19, 2016 Faculty of Medicine meeting and the June 2, 2016 JCSW meeting.
