Call between the hours of: 9:00 a.m. - 4:45 p.m. (M-F). A fee of \$25.00 may be charged for the first half-hour of the consultation. They will make up to three referrals per case, one at a time, no lists provided and no referrals to free attorneys. *Not a free legal service*.

\*\* **<u>CAUTION</u>**: After the initial consultation period is over, the attorney may charge his/her normal rate for the rest of the session. With this in mind, it is advisable to <u>ask about the length of the initial consultation and fee immediately.</u>

\*\*\* Since March of 1991, the **MBA has sponsored a monthly** *Dial-A-Lawyer* program that encourages members of the public to call with their legal problems and questions. First Wednesday of each month, attorneys volunteer at the MBA's Boston headquarters by providing free, basic legal information by phone to callers from 5:30 to 7:30 pm.

Agency will first "evaluate" problems via telephone and then refer client to a lawyer or appropriate agency. No charge for the telephone referral. The charge for a consultation with a lawyer is no more than \$25.00 for the first half-hour. There are reduced fee referrals for those who make \$15,000 or less (gross) and those on public assistance.

\* Reduced fee attorneys charge up to \$75 per hour. No free attorneys.

\* Decision to take a case on a reduced fee basis is made by the attorney.
