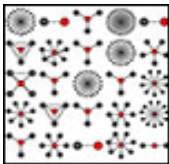


Fat but Fit

Blind cavefish have evolved to be constantly hungry and fat—but also healthy. What can this tell us about human obesity?

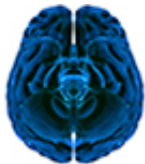
