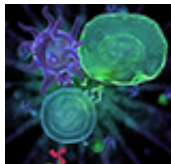




Gender Gap

Women authors are consistently underrepresented in scientific research. A new study reveals some of the fields with the greatest disparities.

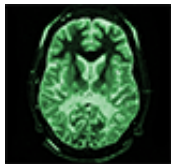

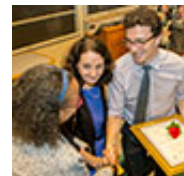
